fter graduation, students can serve in pharmaceutical-related industries and engage in the promotion, development, quality control, manufacturing or marketing of pharmaceuticals. They can also contribute what they have learned to serve pharmaceutical trading companies, government health institutions or academic research units. Currently, a relatively high proportion of pharmacists work in hospital pharmacies or open their own businesses to engage in clinical pharmaceutical services. There are also examples of people who continue to study in post-graduate medicine or Chinese medicine, and then return to clinical medical services after becoming more advanced in their studies. Graduates of the Institute of Clinical Pharmacy are strengthened with "patient-centered" clinical drug evidence-based treatment knowledge, so they can be more competitive in clinical pharmaceutical services in the job market.
